

RATHERT FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

The name of the fund shall be The Rathert Foundation Scholarship Fund. The fund will be used for the purpose of assisting financially in the education of needy and worthy students who are Seniors of Unified School District No. 110 of Kensington, KS. This is a one-year scholarship grant for the amount of at least \$250 (two hundred fifty dollars) at the beginning of each of the two semesters. A recipient will maintain eligibility as long as he or she is a full time student in good standing at the chosen College or Vocational School. This scholarship grant will be paid directly to the College or Vocational School after notification to The Peoples Bank by the recipient.

Applications must be submitted on or before May 1 of the applicant's senior year. The application consists of a written essay of not more than 200 (two hundred) words submitted to the high school principal. The essay needs to include: a personal statement addressing the applicant's reasons for continuing education after high school, a statement of financial need, and a statement of future career and educational goals. A high school transcript and personal data sheet must accompany the essay.

Scholarship recipients will be selected by a committee of three appointed by the Principal of Thunder Ridge High School.
